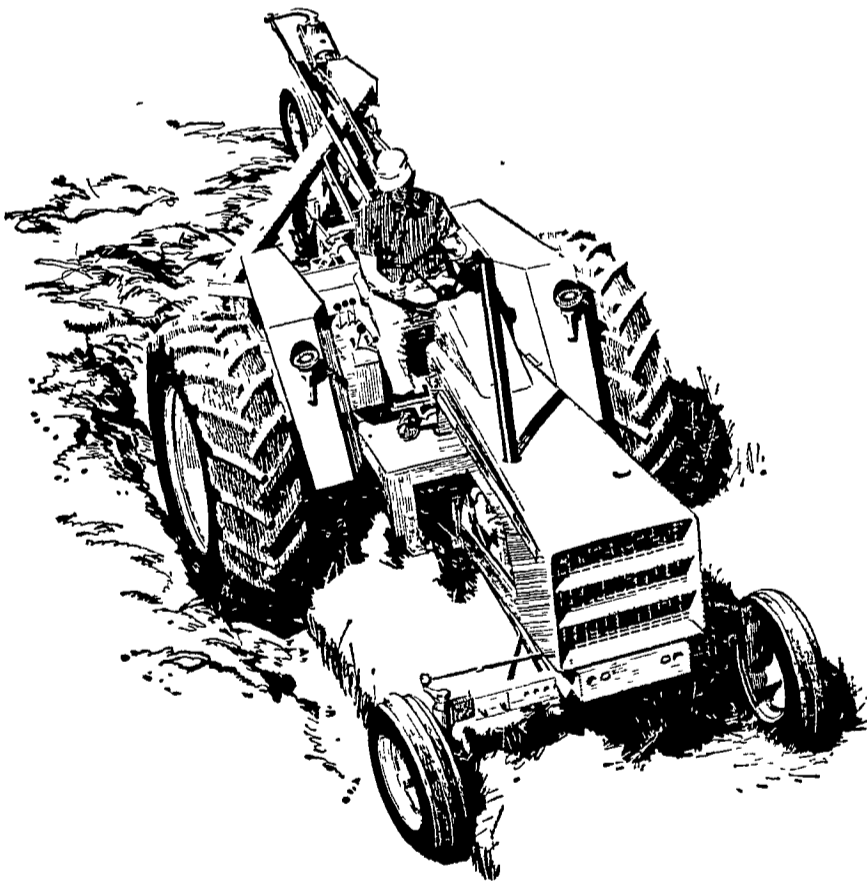

The boys will represent the Pennsylvania FFA poultry judging team in national competition as a result of their outstanding efforts at the state level during FFA Week at Penn State University last June.

Earl Myer, a senior at Penn Manor, placed first in poultry judging in state competition. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Landis Myer of Lancaster R2.

Prevent Damage to Floors
If you wear thin, high heels around the house, you run the risk of damaging your floors. If you weigh 120 pounds and are wearing stiletto heels, you exert a pressure of about 2,000 pounds per square inch every time you take a step. That much pressure damages wood, tile, concrete, metal, — anything you walk on. Waxing the floor will help to protect the floors, also covering with a rug gives added protection.

However, the slender heels can cut the fibers in a rug. The best solution to preventing damage is to wear low heels instead of stiletto heels.

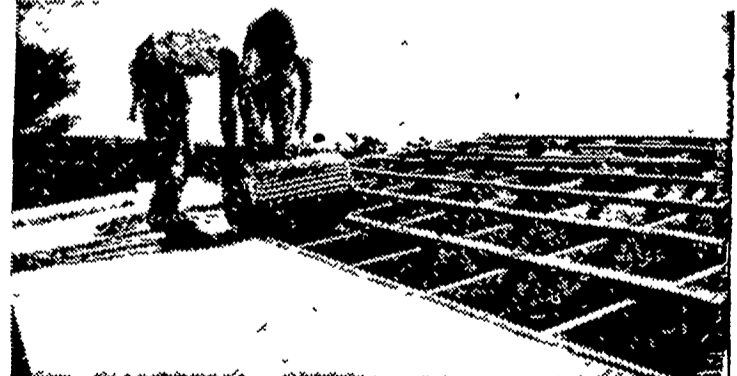
