Compared with last week's close, slaughter steers 25-50 lower, slaughter heifers steady to 50 lower, mostly 25-50 lower, cows steady to 50 lower, largely 25 lower and bulls steady. In the carlot dressed meat trade steer and heifer beef steady to 50 lower, cow beef steady to 50 higher.
