Food Commission

labor are subjects to be considered by the Commission at a hearing in the Senate Caucus Room, Washington, November 3 and 4 Sessions will begin at 9.30 a.m. each day, according to Commission Chairman Phil S Gibson

In announcing the names of organizations and individuals scheduled to testify at the November agricultural cooperation and bargaining hearing, Gibson said:

"Since last April the Commission has held nine public hearings in nine different cities on the marketing of various commodities. Our next two hearings are going to be concerned with the people at the beginning and at the end of the food marketing system — the producers and the consumers"

He added that he hoped witnesses from farm, cooperative, and bargaining organizations would draw upon their own experiences to tell the Commission at its November hearing, how their groups operate, how they have adapted to changing marketing conditions, what they have achieved, and what obstacles they foresee to greater achievements

Established by Congress in July 1964 as a temporary agency assigned to examine the marketing processes involved in getting farm products into the consumer's pantry, the Food Marketing Commission is to report on its study by July 1, 1966. In addition to public hearings, it is obtaining needed information through private interviews, staff research, questionnaires, and statistical studies by other government agencies.

Among witnesses thus far scheduled to appear at the hearing on agricultural cooperation and bargaining will be representatives of the National Council of Farmer Cooperatives, National Grange, National Farmers Union, American Farm Bureau Federation, and National Farmers Organization
