Lancaster County ranks first 1 in the State in the value of agricultural products, and is considered to be the third most popular tourist attraction in Pennsylvania.

Yet with this exceptional record of traffic, of people, and goods created by such a growing and diversified economy, Lancaster County has seen the benefits of only one per cent of the total expenditures for highway construction by the State in the last ten years.
