

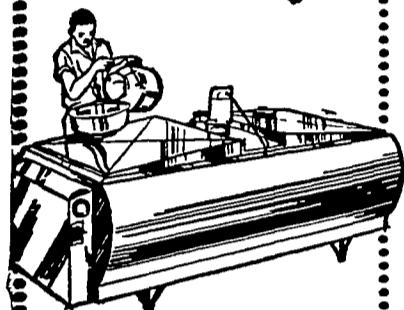

Thorough soaking of the ground around the root zone is very important before the ground freezes. Also it will help with azaleas and holly to erect a windbreak to prevent wind damage and more drying out.

tion with the Pennsylvania Grassland Council, Nissley served as moderator and a resource person.

Garber described his farming program to the group. He operates a dairy with free-stall housing and a milking parlor, and farms corn and some alfalfa. Garber said he uses the Penn State

Forage Testing Program and testing laboratory at Doylestown finds it very helpful in planning feeding programs.

Richard Hackenberger, teacher of agriculture at Penn Manor High School, briefly described the Penn State forage program. His cows are housed in stanchions and the milk is handled by pipeline.

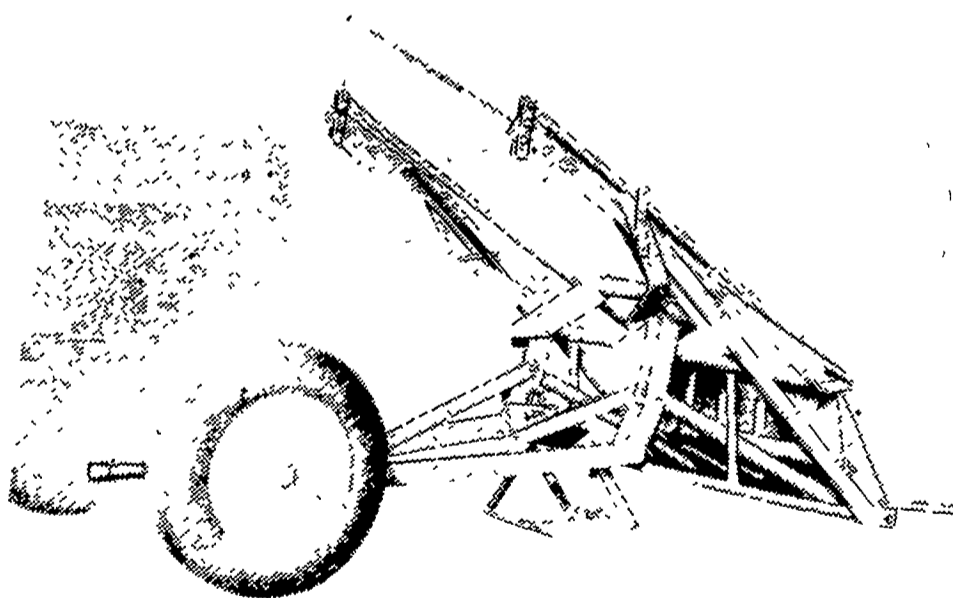
