

Glatfelter Firm Again Offers Tree Seedlings

The 1966 tree planting program of 13 Soil Conservation Districts in this area will again receive the active support of The Glatfelter Pulp Wood Company, Spring Grove Pa. This will be the ninth season this York County firm has offered to furnish ever-

green seedlings for Soil Conservation District cooperators in the following counties: Adams, Berks, Chester, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry, Schuylkill and York

More than 4,400,000 seedlings have been furnished to 1549 District cooperators under this program during the past eight years that this program has been in effect. In Lancaster County, a total of

81,000 seedlings has been planted by 52 landowners during the past eight years.

These totals are in addition to seedlings furnished to other non-district farmers and woodland owners by the Glatfelter firm as part of its over-all program of natural resource conservation. More than seven million seedlings have been planted since 1951 under this program. All seedlings are purchased from Pennsylvania Department of Forests and Waters nurseries and are made available to landowners without any Company-imposed restrictions. The usual state limitations prohibiting use of these trees for Christmas trees, ornamental or windbreak plantings remain in effect. Minimum order acceptable is for 1,000 seedlings

Local District cooperators who have land to be planted as part of their farm conservation plan are advised to contact their local Soil Conservation Service office for more information and application blanks. The SCS office is located at 439 North Duke Street, Lancaster, Pa.

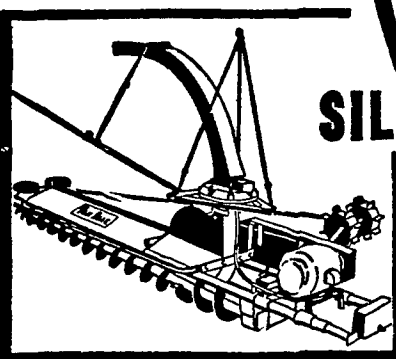
In the all-day session held

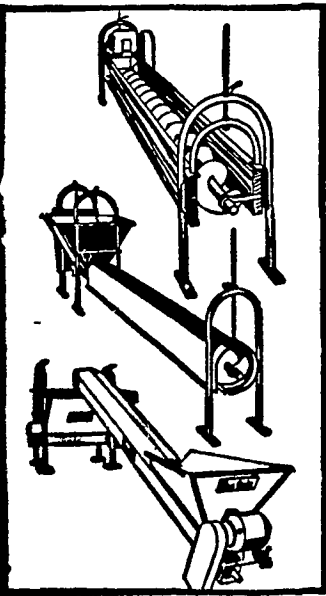

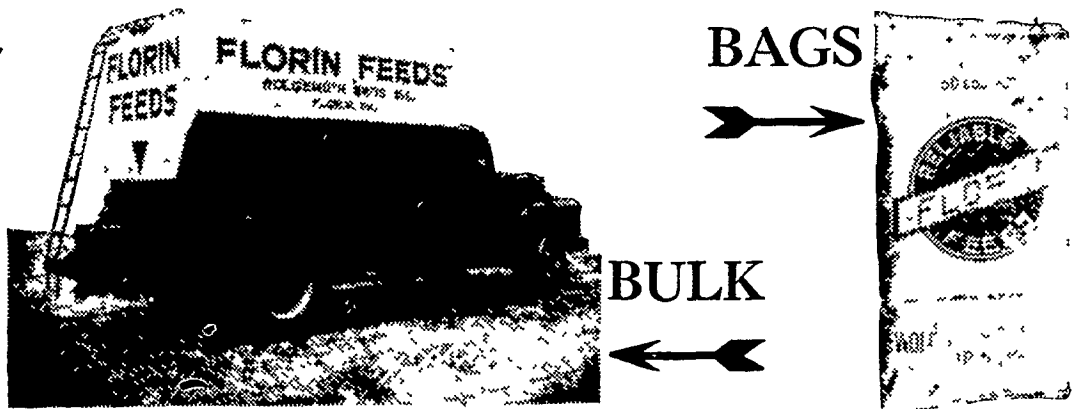
