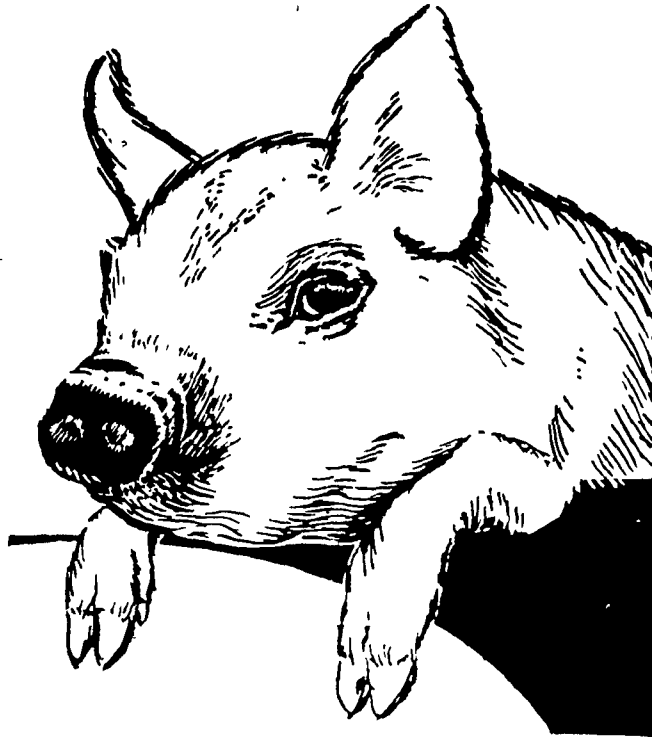


QUESTION:

How Do Our Hog Rations Perform?



ANSWER:

Many of our customers do not keep good hog feeding records. Hogs from the same lot are often marketed at different times. Some feed some of their own corn without keeping track of the weight and often exact knowledge of feeder pig weight is not available.

Mr. Landis Sangrey of Columbia, R. D. 2 does keep accurate records and here is what he found:

On September 7, 1965, he bought 65 Yorkshire Landrace Cross feeder pigs at an average weight of 20 lbs.

From December 21, 1965, to January 24, 1966, he sold them at an average weight of 221.9 lbs.

Average daily gain for a feeding period of 113 days 1.7867 lbs.

Lbs. of feed used per lb. of meat produced
feed-meat ratio 3.03 lbs.

Feeding Program:

#701 Green Pastures Pig Starter Pellets until pigs reached 40 lb. weight.

#702 Green Pastures Pig Grower Pellets from 40 - 75 lbs.

#703 Green Pastures Swine Finisher Pellets from 75 lbs. to market.

ally eased. However, soon the manufacturers' ingredient stocks dwindled dangerously as they awaited overdue truck and rail deliveries.

Hatcheries began to have their problems early in the week also. Chicks hatched with complete disregard for road or weather conditions, caring only that they had been sealed in their calcium castles for twenty-one days, and now they wanted to get growing. In many large hatcheries chicks are hatched several times each week. A four or five day disruption of a hatchery's delivery schedule can be noisy and costly.

The blizzard of '66 left its mark on Lancaster County, and its calling cards may be strewn along county lanes for the rest of the winter.

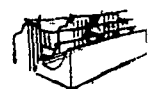

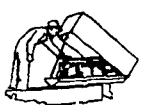
