cent voiced direct opposition to the bill. Only 9 percent were in favor of it, and 5.6 percent indicated they had not yet formed an opinion.

Ammon then went on to say that these results clearly reinforce the statement of policy adopted by NEPPCO in October 1964 which reads:

"This Council supports the original concept of the Agricultural Marketing Agreement Act limiting federal

marketing orders to the smallest practical area, and to the control of marketing of agricultural products.

"We oppose the use of federal marketing orders to control production and believe the use of nationwide marketing orders covering all producers of a commodity would be unworkable because they could not recognize the many and varied differences in production and marketing conditions in the various areas of the country. We further believe enforce-

ment and administration would be excessively costly and would seriously abridge individual freedom and initiative."

Senator Case's motives were, according to the NEPPCO spokesman, quite commendable. However, to propose national legislation, just for the purpose of solving what NEPPCO describes as a purely local problem in New Jersey, is not working in the best interests of the entire industry.

Hearings on the proposed legislation have now been concluded. As yet there is no clear indication of the ultimate outcome, although Washington observers give it little chance of passage in this session.

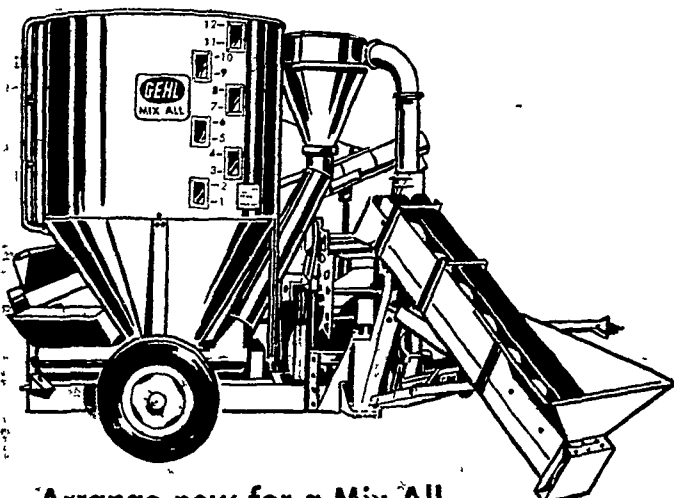
