Scott Ankium and Stanley Stauffer Jr were appointed in charge of ticket sales for the Grange's annual turkey supper to be held April 2.

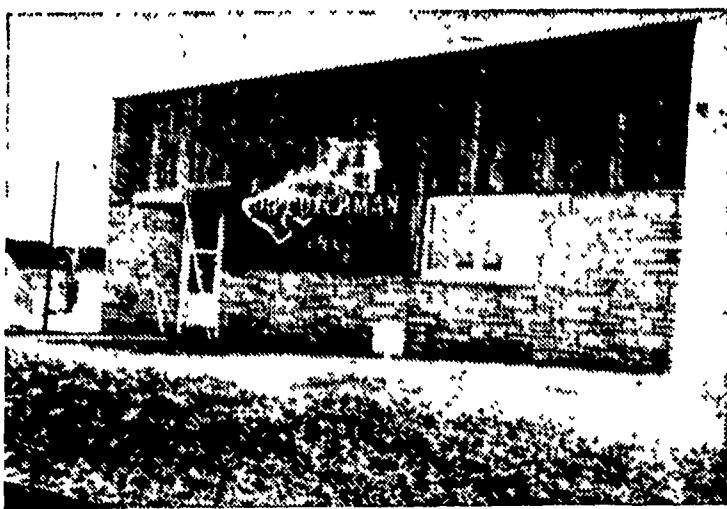

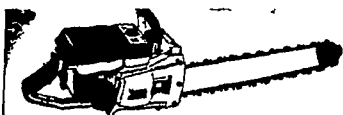

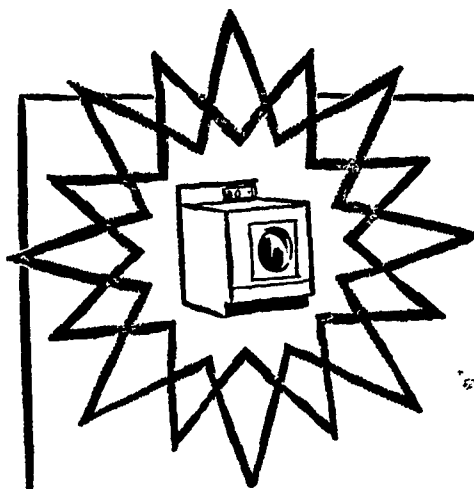
