inch round cutter. Using smaller cookie cutter of various designs, cut center from half of the rounds. Either use centers of cut round or reroll dough and cut designs. Place on buttered baking sheet; bake in a preheated 350 degree oven for 6-8 minutes. Remove to wire rack to cool. Spread Butter Cream Filling on plain rounds and top with cut out round or design. Makes 3 dozen.

***BUTTER CREAM FILLING**
2 cups sifted confectioners sugar
3-4 tablespoons hot milk
2 tablespoons butter, softened
1/2 teaspoon vanilla

Blend together sugar, milk, butter and vanilla; add peppermint to taste. Beat until of spreading consistency.

Some Tips For Keeping Carpets And Rugs Looking Their Best

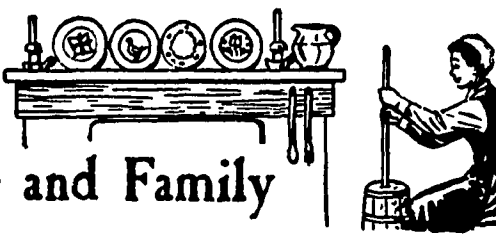
When carpet or rug pile is crushed down because of furniture pressure or constant walking, try a hot iron over a damp cloth or a steam iron on the spots. Let the steam do the work — don't press the iron down on the pile. While the pile is slightly moist, brush up the spots gently. Simple and easy to do, but worth the time.

Some parts of rugs and carpets get harder wear than others. For better looks and longer life, give these heavily traveled areas a breathing spell. Move the furniture and reverse the rugs from time to time and you'll distribute wear on them. When you can not reverse the floor covering, arrange the furniture so you get different traffic lanes.

Ladies, Have You Heard? . . .

Turkey Is Kind To Food Budget

No longer do you need to think of turkey as the traditional whole roasted bird that comes to the table. You can try turkey rolls, patties, drumsticks, thighs, or wings.

For the small family, roasting cutup pieces of turkey is ideal. They leave more space in the oven so the vegetables and desserts can make a complete oven meal. With pieces, it's easy to prepare just what you need for the family with no leftovers unless you plan for them.

If you can't find turkey pieces, ask the man at the poultry counter to halve or quarter the turkey. This gets the amount down to family size. Roast the piece as you would

a whole turkey. Put in a flat, open pan on a rack and roast at 350 degrees allowing 20 to 25 minutes per pound. If using a meat thermometer, insert it on the side of the thigh next to the bird and roast the turkey until the thermometer reads 185 degrees. If you want dressing, prepare it with turkey broth and bake it in a covered pan.

Plastic Houseplants

It's amazing how many types of houseplants you can find in plastic. Such plants don't need watering and can be kept glossy with a soap or detergent bath. You can plant an indoor garden with such varieties as Chinese evergreen, English ivy, philodendron, and others.

Plastic plants and flowers hardly take the place of nature's own, but they have an advantage where soot, steam

heat, and lack of sunlight are constant hazards.

Although a plastic garden may not need watering, it will get grimy unless its leaves are dust-free. To keep the leaves glossy, just use warm soapsuds on a sponge and wipe each stem, leaf, and petal. Then wipe with clear water. This will keep greenery looking alive the year round.
