### LESS GRAIN SUPPORTED

Pennsylvania taimers put very little of their 1965 grain. crops under federal price support loans, the State Agriculture Department noted to-

Only 201.661 bushels of the state's 1965 wheat crop were under price support loan at the end of January —less than two-tenths of one percent of the national total of 164,025,675 bushels. Pennsylvania's wheat crop last year was estimated at 14,280,000 bushels.

Even less corn was put under loan. Out of a crop of 53,300,000 bushels in the state last year, only 61.829 bushel's were under loan at the end of January This was only three-hundredth of one percent of the 1965 corn under l'oan in the nation, 181,-822,543 bushels.
