of 27,000 to a high of 31,000 acres.  
Based on the 1960-64 average yield of 1,795 pounds, a crop of about 45 million pounds of Pennsylvania Seed potatoes would be produced. This would be 5 percent less than the 1965 crop.

**Potato Growers Plan 3 Percent Increase**  
As of March 1, Commonwealth potato growers intended to increase their total potato acreage by 3 percent above last year. This places indicated planted acreage for 1966 at 39,000 acres.  
If these intentions are carried out, it would be 1,000 more acres planted this year

than last year but 600 less than the 1960-64 average acreage. Historic records show the largest acreage planted was 308,000 acres in 1917. The smallest acreage was 38,000 in both 1963 and 1965. During the past 10 years acreage has ranged from 38,000 to 46,000 acres.

Based on the 1960-64 average yield of 191 hundredweight, production would be about 7.4 million hundredweight. This would be 1 percent below production a year ago and the 5-year average. Yield of the 1965 crop at 198 hundredweight was the highest since 1961.

**U.S. TO PLANT MORE POTATOES**

Prospective plantings of late summer and fall potatoes in 1966 are expected to total 1,204,200 acres—3 percent more than 1965 plantings. Expected acreage in the Eastern and Central regions is up 1 percent from 1965 and a 5 percent increase is expected in the West

**TERMS TO KNOW**

The terms "irregulars" and "seconds" used in hosiery advertisements don't mean the same thing, say Penn State extension clothing specialists. The Federal Trade Commission has ruled that "irregular" means hosiery fails to meet the standards for first quality and contains only minor imperfections, such as irregularities in length, foot sizes, color, or knit. "Seconds" don't meet either first quality or irregular standards because they contain actual damage, such as runs.

**LOTTA TOMATOES IN '66**

**HARRISBURG** — Sharp increases in production of tomatoes and peas for processing are indicated in early planting intentions of state growers.

Tomato growers expect to plant 10,500 acres this year, 25 percent more than last year's acreage of 8,400. Tomato acreage in the nation is expected to be up 12 percent from last year.

An estimated 6,000 acres will be planted to green peas in the state, a 7 percent increase over last year. This compares to an anticipated increase of 3 percent in the nation.

Pennsylvania asparagus growers expect to harvest 850 acres this year, the same as in 1965.
