1913. is reportedly one of Lebanon County's finest Last year's herd average for the 70 Reist cows was 14,756 pounds of milk and 570 pounds of fat.

Another dairy herd, owned by Howard Weiss, was second high heid in Lebanon County

for butterfat for the past two years. This farm features a five-wagon hay drying system, and will be the final dairy stop on the tour.

The outstanding veal production farm of Ammon Martin will also be seen. Martin has 116 units for handling veal calves, and markets 10-12 head every week. His operation has

been described as one of the most outstanding in the country.

One non-farm stop will be at the San Giorgio macaroni factory, said to be the most automated factory of its kind in the world.

The noon meal will be catered and will include breaded veal, spaghetti, bread and roll, salad, milk or coffee, and ice cream. The total cost of the tour will be \$400, including the meal.
