sent property from 86 acres to 145 acres. This would involve the addition of city-owned and state hospital land, as well as Glen-Gery Brick Co. land.

It was felt by the Secretary and Farm Show officials that only by expanding and modernizing the present facilities can Pennsylvania capture some

of the large national shows. One of these cited, The National Dairy Show, is being bid for by other states with such competing facilities as dormitories for 2200 young people, and a guarantee of \$50,000 for the next ten years. "This is the kind of competition we're up against," Bull said in explaining why the Farm Show complex must be re-modeled.

The Secretary said the first building would not be built in less than four years, and the second in six to eight years.

### New USDA Computer Center In Service

Secretary Freeman dedicated a new data processing center of the U.S. Department of Agriculture last week. The center is located in the department's South Office Building in Washington, D.C.

The center currently works for 13 USDA agencies, handling about 100 jobs per day on such projects as crop estimates, rural telephone rates, and research on wheat movement.

The facility, using some 28,000 square feet, is expected by the end of the year to be handling all the data that were formerly processed by renting time on 11 different computers in seven locations.
