test a week ago.

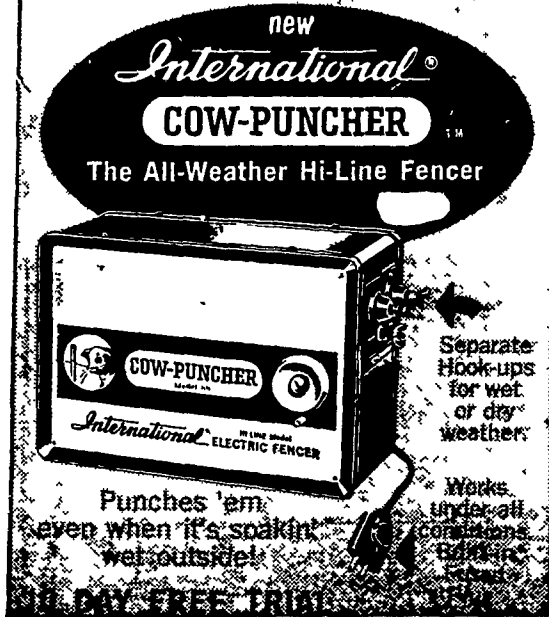
Last week's county winner,
