Compared with last Friday, Slaughter Steers sold 50-1.25 lower, generally 1.00 lower. Slaughter Heifers were 75-1.00 lower, Cows steady to 50 lower and Bulls closed weak to 1.00 lower. In the carlot dressed meat trade, steer beef 1.00-1.50 lower, heifer beef 1.00-1.25 lower and cow beef steady to 50 lower.

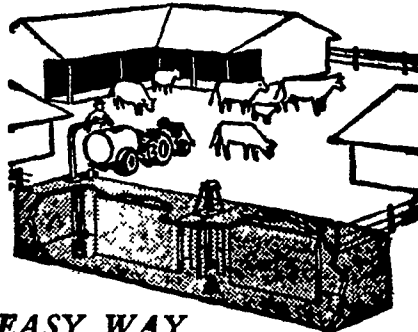
