## 5-County Workshop For 4-H Teen Leaders

A five-county Teen Leadership Workshop was held at Camp Innabah near Pughtown last week. Sixty-six 4-H Teen Leaders from Bucks, Montgomery, Philadelphia, Delaware and Chester Counties attended the camping workshop sponsored by the Urban Youth Committee of the Agricultural and Home Economics Extension Service. The program was designed to assist teen leaders in the five county area in understanding their role as a leader and how to work with the younger 4-H members in their respective clubs. The workshop consisted of discussions and demonstrations in Health and National Awards conducted by Beverly Steely, student and former 4-H member attending Susquehanna University; Tools for Teaching conducted by George Mansell, Montgomery County Agent; Telling the 4-H Story to the Community, Mrs. George Siegfries, Montgomery County;

Working with Younger 4-H Members, Miss Patricia Kelley, assistant state 4-H Leader; and Community Service, conducted by Mrs. Sandra M. Eaton, Home Economist in Chester County.

The 4-H teen leaders participated in other activities as well. Donald Morway, Psychologist with the Aerospace Medical Research Department at the Naval Aviation Development Center, talked with them and showed a movie of "Our Men in Space." Allan Brown, an International Farm Youth Exchange delegate who had just returned from a six-month visit in Mexico, gave them an understanding of youth in that country. Folk singing, dancing, and recreation with the leadership angle in mind, was also included in the two day program.
