Dr. Kenneth Wing of Cornell University will cover the long-range impact of New Egg Division of the Wake-

York Mercantile Exchange Corp., the wholesale trading arm of the Shop-Rite Chain Stores. At one time or another in his long career, Karadbil has been involved in every phase of the egg industry from production through retail sales.

These three new members will join six other well-known industry names in completing the school faculty. The others, who have

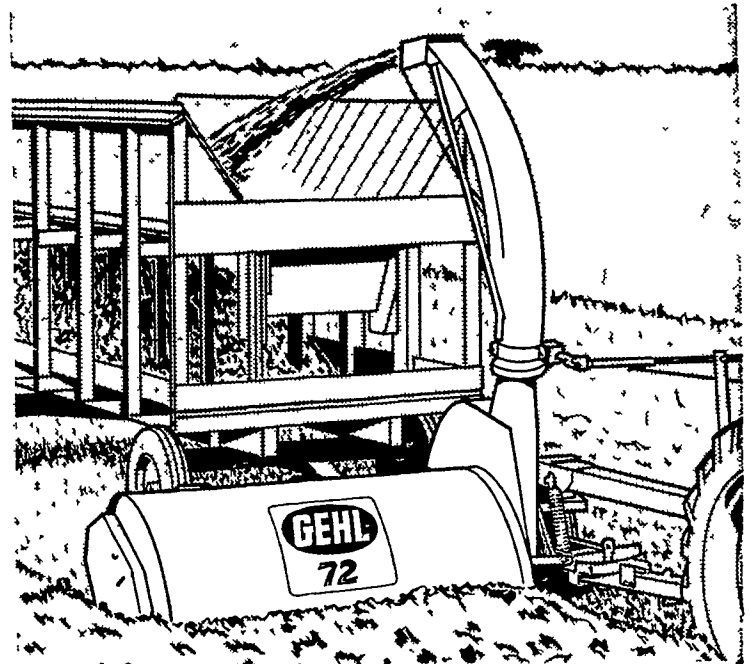
