Compared with last weeks close slaughter steers 25-1.00 lower, mostly 50-75 lower. Slaughter heifers 25-50 lower, cows steady to 50 higher. Bulls generally 50 higher. In the carlot dressed meat trade, Good and Choice steer and heifer beef 50-1.50 lower with most decline on Choice. Standard steer beef steady. Cow beef steady to 1.00 higher with Utility and Commercial advancing.
