

Poultry Federation Annual Conference Set For June 22 and 23

Pennsylvania poultrymen plan to take a good look at egg production and marketing trends in all areas of the nation when the Pennsylvania Poultry Federation holds its Annual Conference at Pennsylvania State University on June 22 and 23.

One of the main speakers will be Fred Bailey, Jr., of Farm Communications, Inc., Washington, D. C., who will present a national report on timely issues affecting the poultry industry. Bailey, a

graduate of both Purdue University and Indiana University, serves as Washington editor for a number of publications with national circulation. He also handles public relations work in the agricultural area. During the course of his work in Washington, he has had the opportunity to interview and to work with many top officials in government and was granted the first exclusive magazine interview with L. B. Johnson after he became president. For the past five years Bailey served as consultant to an agency of the USDA. A number of other

speakers well-known to poultrymen and prominent in the industry will present views of what's happening in the Far West, the Southeast, and the Northeast.

Instead of the usual "Poultryman of The Year" Award at the annual banquet on the first night of the conference, Federation members will pay tribute to Dr. A. J. G. Maw, head of the Poultry Science Department, and Dr. R. Russell Murphy, a member of the Poultry Science Department staff, both of whom are retiring from Pennsylvania State University on July 1.
