Shunk stated, "Also seriously considered was the area's natural hilly terrain which teatures a rustic, wilderness appearance." He emphasized, "PP&L intends to preserve the setting's natural appearance — an approach PP&L believes is particularly important in view of the increasing scalcity of such outdoor setreats in the face of spreading heavily populated areas'


