**VIT-Y-MIN**

**\$-Million Area  
Recreation Plan  
Set By PP&L**

"Recreation facilities for the public in the area of Pennsylvania Power & Light Company's Holtwood power plant and Lake Aldred on the Susquehanna River are being considerably expanded," the Lancaster and York county commissioners and planning commissions were told at meetings in Lancaster and

York this week. Speaking for PP&L, Brentwood S. Shunk, the company's Lancaster district manager, stated, "The work which is presently underway is part of a one million dollar program for providing additional outdoor recreation opportunities for the public in the Holtwood area. This money will be spent between now and 1980, with more than half of it scheduled over the next two years. "This is a carefully planned

project," Shunk explained. "Individual facilities in this development program were determined after a comprehensive study was made by a highly-qualified engineering research organization with experience in recreation planning. Tippetts-Abbett-McCarthy-Stratton, which was assisted by a local York firm, Buchart-Horn. Before arriving at their recommendations, the firms studied the present use of Lake Aldred and PP&L facilities already there, the needs and preferences of the tributary population for recreation and, finally, the composition of the regional, predominantly urban, population."

Shunk stated, "Also seriously considered was the area's natural hilly terrain which features a rustic, wilderness appearance." He emphasized, "PP&L intends to preserve the setting's natural appearance — an approach PP&L believes is particularly important in view of the increasing scarcity of such outdoor retreats in the face of spreading heavily populated areas."

In estimating the number of people who will be able to use the facilities PP&L will provide, Shunk stated, "In 1968 when the major portion of the work will be complete, there will be facilities to accommodate an estimated 120,000 visitors annually. By 1980 we expect to accommodate 230,000."

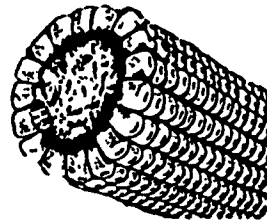
PP&L's development of the area by that time will feature more than 300 picnic tables at the Otter Creek, Pequea Creek, Urey, Pinnacle Overlook Holtwood Recreation Areas and Pequea Picnic Area. Of these sites, Pinnacle Overlook, Pequea Creek, Otter Creek and Urey Recreation Areas will have over 300 campsites. Also at Pequea Picnic Area, Urey Recreation Area and other desirable locations rimming Lake Aldred, over 10 boat launching ramps will supplement existing facilities at Otter Creek Recreation Area.

An area of historical interest will be developed and 100 picnic tables will be provided near Lock 12 of the old Susquehanna and Tidewater Canal. More than 450 picnic tables will be provided on Lake Aldred's islands which will be prepared for daytime recreation. Work will start with the Urey Island group at the end of the 1966 season and will continue over the next three years on an island-by-island basis. All mainland picnic and recreation areas will have trash disposal, toilet and drinking water facilities. The islands will have trash and toilet facilities.
