planted and harvested by ma-In the six-county corn vari- chine, as it would normally hybrids, the crop will be about 19,000 per acre, Lueck said Two rows each of twenty-four commercial varieties were planted /at once with Boll's two-row planter, with the rows measuring approximately 750 feet in length.

The companies and their respective varieties are Agway-800, 876X; Doebler-66X, 77X; Eastland - 812, 600X, Funk—G-4697, G-4601; Beachly-Asgrow—ASC 95; Hardy-400X, 600X; DeKalb-XL 362, 640, Muncy Chief-770X, 880X; Northrup King-PX 616, PX 674; Pfister—SX 29, 399, Pioneer—323, 3306; Todd-92A, 92B Pennsylvania 820 is being used as a check.

According to farmer Richard Boll, who assisted Lueck in planting the plot, they plowed down 800 pounds of 20-10-10 fertilizer, and used 250 pounds of starter fertilizer with a 10-24-12 analysis in the planter The soil, a deep, silt loam, was treated for insects by spraying two quarts of chlordane per acre, Boll




