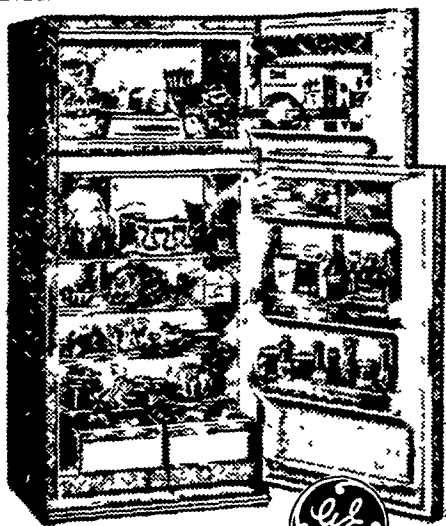

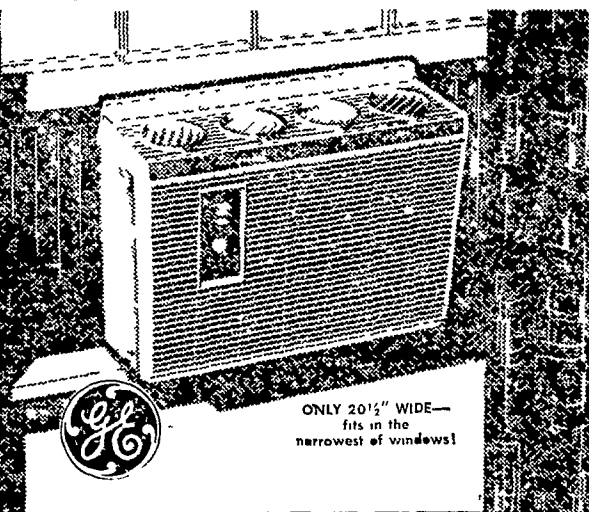

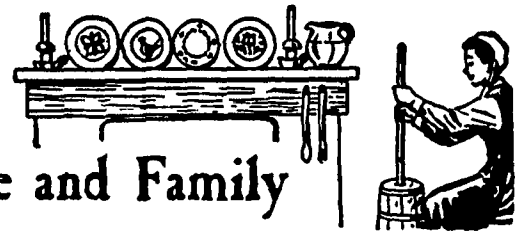

**SPAGHETTI SALAD**

- 8 ounces elbow spaghetti or macaroni
- 2 cans (7 oz. each) tuna, drained and flaked
- 3/4 cup chopped celery
- 3/8 cup sliced pimiento-stuffed green olives
- 1/4 cup chopped onion
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise or salad dressing
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- Curly endive or water cress sprigs

Set out an 8-inch ring mold. Cook spaghetti or macaroni in boiling, salted water until tender, yet firm, 5 to 7 minutes; drain. Rinse with cold water and drain thoroughly. Meanwhile, in large mixing bowl combine tuna, celery, olives and onion. Fold in spaghetti. Prepare Tomato Aspic. Fold 4 cups spaghetti salad mixture into aspic. Rinse ring mold with cold water and spoon in aspic mixture. Chill until firm, about 4 hours. Blend mayonnaise or salad dressing, lemon juice and salt. Pour over remaining spaghetti salad and mix lightly. Cover and chill. Unmold aspic ring onto serving plate. Fill center with remaining spaghetti salad. Garnish aspic ring with curly endive or water cress sprigs. Serve immediately.

**Use Protein Foods In Summer Salads**

If a salad is the main course, use generous quantities of protein foods. Choose from

- Sardines
- Anchovies
- Cheese
- Canned meat
- Sandwich meat
- Cooked pork, beef, lamb, chicken, or turkey
- Hard-cooked eggs

For extra flavor to hearty salads, marinate cubes or strips of cooked beef, pork, or lamb in vinegar or lemon juice seasoned with herbs at least an hour before adding to the salad.

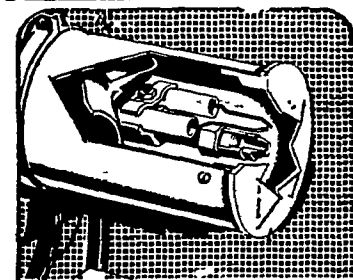
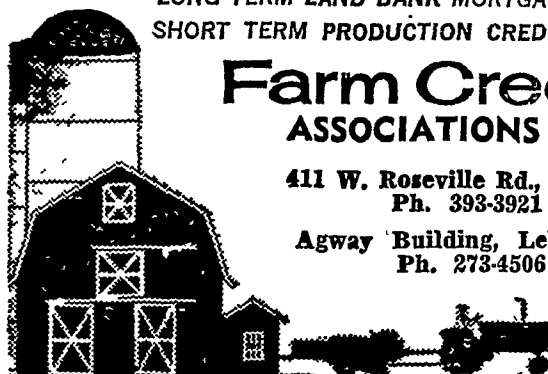
