says Dr. Stuart Patton, in charge of experiments leading to the new product. It should make a better quality whole milk, often termed nature's most perfect food, available to more people, Patton points out.

Patton and associates believe the new dry whole milk will appeal to both the consumer and the dairy farmer. Dry whole milk presently available is not widely accepted as a beverage although powdered skim milk has a large market in this country. Tasty dry whole milk could increase the sale and use of milk, Dr. Patton reports, especially in areas of the world where fresh milk is not avail-

able.

The improved process has been evaluated in both industrial and government laboratories and has been found an effective means of improving dry whole milk.

A commercial product based on the process is undergoing test marketing.

The newly patented process takes milk fat, separated from whole milk, and treats it with steam under a relatively high vacuum. This step forms and removes flavor substances that would create a problem during storage. The fat can then be re-emulsified into skim milk. At this point the product can be evaporated into dry whole milk or can be used in dry ice cream mixes or dry cream powders.

The Agricultural Experiment Station at Penn State reports that some leading milk product manufacturers are considering the development.

**To Control Corn Borer**

Early sweet corn growers may want to do everything possible to have a big early crop of corn; this is usually to the growers' advantage. Corn borers reduce the vitality of the stalk and better yields will result if they are controlled. The first treatment should be given at the appearance of the tassel in the whorl of the plant and repeated four times at 5-day intervals; either DDT or Sevin may be used. If the fodder is to be fed to livestock, do not use DDT.
