Eastern Pennsylvania And New Jersey WEEKLY SUMMARY

LIVE HENS

Prices on light hens held unchanged. Supplies lighter but offerings adequate to barely adequate for decreased needs. Demand generally fair. Limited supplies of heavy hens adequate for current needs. Some buyers reluctant at the 18c level in view of lower markets at Southern points. Prices paid at farm, light hens 9½-11, mostly 10-10½; heavy hens, too few sales to report prices.

TURKEYS

Offerings light, especially toms. Buying interest limited. Occasional small lots of heavy hens 13-14¢, average moved @28c.

Eastern Shore Exchange WEEKLY SUMMARY

Lot average broiler and fryer prices this week lost almost ½ cent to average 15.16 compared to 15.55 cent per lb. last week.

Prices paid during the week ranged from a high of 16.2 cents per lb. on Tuesday to a low of 14.4 cents per lb. on Thursday.

Sales for the week showed a slight decrease over the preceding week at 14 million head.

Delmarva

June 30, 1966

Delmarva broiler and fryer lot average prices declined from 15.55 to 15.03 cents per lb. Demand fair for moderate auction offerings. Live supplies adequate on 2-3 lb. birds, short on heavier weights due to hot weather reducing growth rate.

Ready-to-cook demand remains very good with most plants running at or near capacity.

Estimated slaughter for Thursday, 919,000 head compared to 929,000 head last Thursday.

In the 24 hours preceding market close Thursday, at farm prices paid for broilers and fryers ranged from 14.7 to 15.5 cents per lb. on reported sales totaling 1 million head.

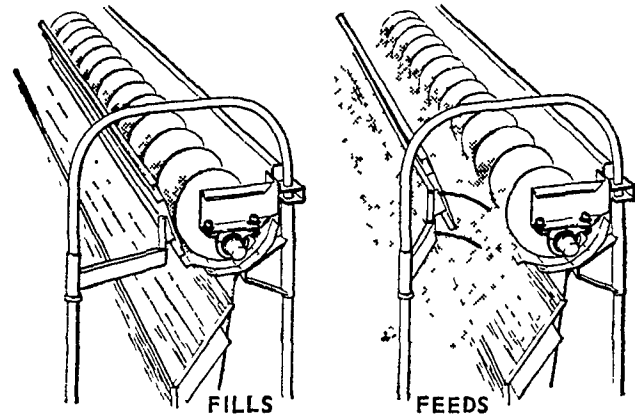
