Compared with last weeks close, slaughter steers were steady to 25 lower, with the decline mostly in High Good to High Choice. Slaughter heifers sold steady. Cows were steady and bulls were weak to 25 lower. In the carlot dressed meat trade, steer beef sold steady to 50 lower, heifer beef was steady to 50 higher, and cow beef was steady to 1.00 higher.
