

Area Holsteins Complete Milk and Fat Records

Registered Holstein cows in Lancaster County herds recently completed new official milk and butterfat records according to the Holstein-Friesian Association of America. Three of these herds in the Lititz area, two in

Lancaster and one in Elizabethtown.

Three Holsteins on the Isaac M. Brubaker farm, Lititz, were listed in the association report. Bruk-Vil Daisy Forward Ivanhoe, a three-year-old, had 17,220 pounds of milk and 722 of fat in 364 days. Another three-year-old, Bruk-Vil Verna Sue Ivanhoe, produced 14,390 of milk and 621 of fat in 305 days. Bruk-Vil Vera Vicki Ivanhoe, a four-year-old had 14,090 pounds of milk and 616

of butterfat in 331 days.

At the Titus M. Hurst farm, Lititz, Rollingstead Sir Mono and 637 lbs. of butterfat in 338 days. Lucinda Ivanhoe Patricia, a six-year-old, produced 22,198 of milk and 764 pounds of fat in 361 days. Roseland-lbs. of milk and 584 lbs of fat in 317 days. All are owned by Melvin G. Peifer, Lancaster.

Five cows in the Henry E Kettering herd were reported. A five-year-old, Henket Eva Ivanhoe, produced 15,800 milk and 851 pounds of fat in 305 days. Henket Reflection Dee, three-year-old, had 16,840 milk and 766 fat in 345 days. Another three-year-old, Henket Dean Tess, made 17,270 milk and 687 pounds of fat in 353 days, while four-year-old Sunny Craft Mae Ivanhoe produced 18,160 of milk and 719 of fat in 304 days. A two-year-old, Henket Ivanhoe Evelyn, produced 17,500 of milk and 604 of fat in 350 days.

Strickst Lucifer Star, a five-year-old, produced 21,040 of milk and 978 of butterfat in 365 days. Strickst Ivanhoe Cheerio, a four-year-old, had 18,168 of milk and 842 lbs of butterfat in 347 days. Strickst Myrtle Ivanhoe, a three-year-old, had 18,175 lbs. of milk and 806 lbs of butterfat in 347 days. Strickst Joe Sensation Ivanhoe, another three-year-old, had 23,856 of milk and 719 lbs of fat in 305 days. All are owned by Hiram S Aungst, Elizabethtown.

Spring Lawn Ivanhoe A X Gem, a four-year-old, produced 17,340 lbs of milk and 822 lbs of fat in 325 days. Spring Lawn Dean Z Wovation, a six-year-old, had 15,750 lbs of milk and 691 lbs of butterfat in 297 days. Both are owned by Jay C. Garber, Lancaster.

Baurdele Standard Fanny, a five-year-old, produced 18,130 of milk and 676 of butterfat in 322 days. Jonadel Yvonne Korndyke Yola, a three-year-old, had 17,800 lbs of milk

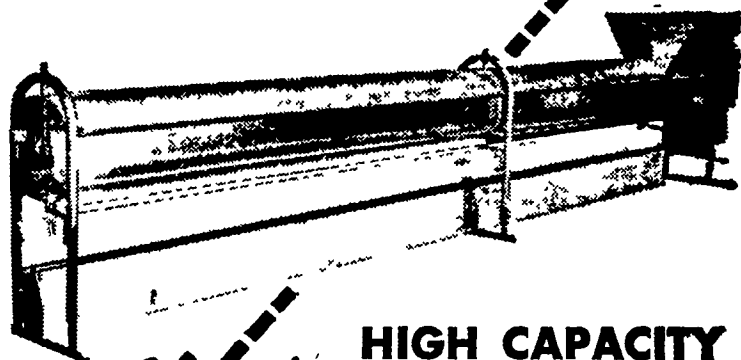

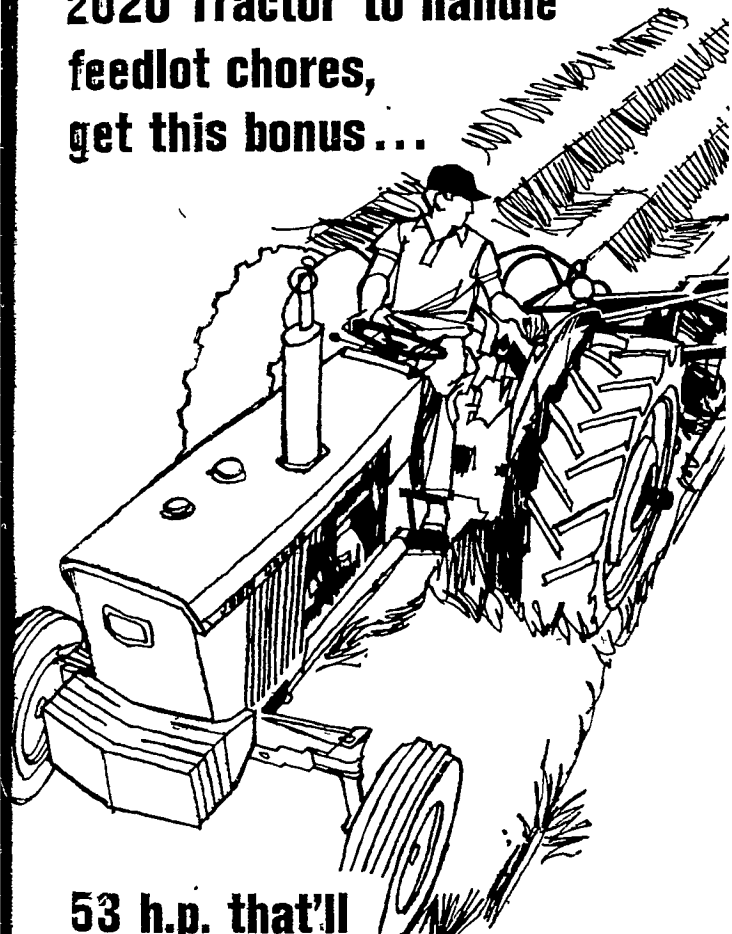
