 new developments in the method of measuring milk flow will soon be forthcoming, making the milk-o-meter method obsolete

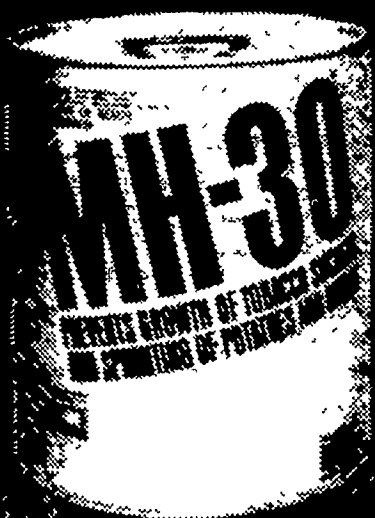
