Little exact information is now available, he stated, on the extent to which irrigation has been adopted on farms in the state and on future needs. More data is needed on the source of water used, amounts used, kinds of systems being operated, kinds of crops watered, and on its economic feasibility.

Bull said demands for water for various uses are increasing rapidly, and that if agriculture is to have a fair share its needs must be determined quickly

The survey was requested by irrigation experts, water conservationists, farmers, and representatives of various governmental agencies at a meeting called by the Department of Agriculture.
