Calf Losses Increase With Herd Size

Research has found that calf losses increased from an average of 11.9% in herds with less than 30 cows to 18.4% in herds with 100 cows or more. It is difficult to upgrade a dairy herd even if all heifer calves are saved. If losses are higher, the difficulties increase. Many dairymen are in an expansion program. At best it is difficult to expand without home raised heifers. Dairymen should remember it takes a replacement per year for every three or four cows in their milking herd. There is, it was noted, much room for reducing calf losses in all herd sizes. It may be more important because the number of small dairy herds, with a surplus of heifers for sale, is declining. Greater attention to freshening cows and new born calves and providing better starter facilities could do much to lower the calf loss.

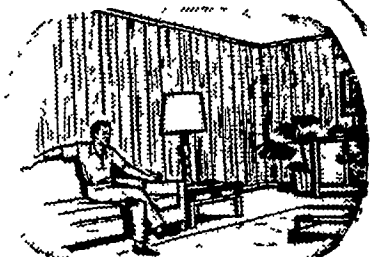
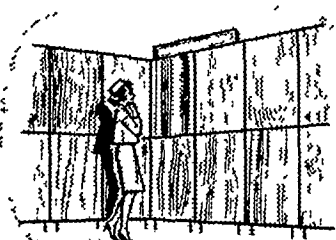
