## Champion Steer Brings 90c At Livestock Exp.

The grand champion steer of the Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition, a 1,015-pound Angus, brought 90 cents a pound at the Thursday afternoon auction. It was shown by Jay W. Fought, of Mechanicsburg R2, Cumberland County, and was purchased by Daniel W. George, of George's Foodliner, Bethlehem. Last year's champion brought \$2.25 a pound and the 1964 winner, another Angus shown by Fought, brought \$1.15 a pound.

The grand champion beef carcass, weighing 512 pounds, shown by Jay Coble, of Locust Lane Farm, Hershey R1, brought \$1.10 a pound—five cents more a pound than Coble's champion Angus carcass that was sold last year.

The champion lamb carcass, a Hampshire weighing 59 pounds and shown by Jack Shoher of Somerset County, was sold for \$1.75 a pound to Kunzler & Co., of Lancaster. Last year's champion lamb carcass brought \$1.25 a pound.

The champion barrow went for \$1.05 a pound to Arbogast and Bastian, of Allentown. It was exhibited by Caryl Smith, of Jamestown, Ohio.

The champion wether, a 105-pound Southdown shown by Kenneth Mosher, of Cardington, Ohio, was sold to Daniel W. George for 60 cents a pound.

tufts or loops in the rug. Bend the surface of the rug. There should be no wide gaps between the rows of pile. Yarns support each other and resist abrasion in a rug with closely packed tufts.

Height of the pile adds to

durability. If you compare rugs of the same quality of fiber and size of yarn, the rug with more fiber will wear better.

Use top grades in heavy traffic areas. Economy grade rugs or carpets can be used in rooms you use less.
