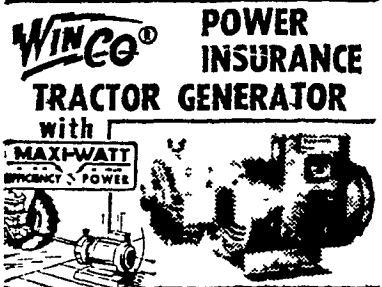

Deadlines already have passed, Mann said, for most classes of poultry, dairy and beef cattle, swine, lambs, breeding sheep, draft horses, and the Folk Dance Festival, also collective apiary displays, school exhibits and demonstrations

Because of the large volume of these entries the Farm Show office indicated more time will be required for processing them. Tentative forecasts were that, as in other recent years, all space will be taken in both the competitive and commercial sections of the big show.

State Secretary of Agriculture Leland H. Bull said the Farm Show theme — A Progressive Agriculture Benefits You—the Consumer — will "focus attention on the customers who buy the farmer's produce, and on his ability to fill their need for an increasing volume of foodstuffs."

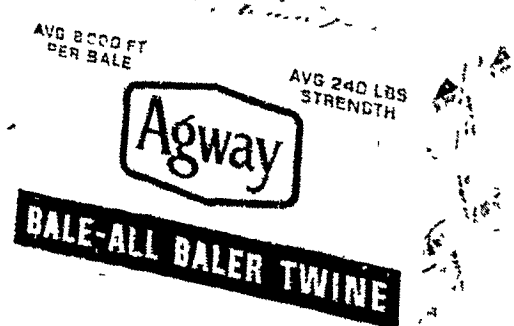
