At the sale following the district show, Ikey was bought by Thomas E. Strauss, operator of Miller's Smorgasbord, for 70 cents a pound.

Not to be limited to the top honor in the show, Lancaster County youths went on to take breed championships in the Hereford and Shorthorn classes, and finally, reserve grand champion.

William Houser's 1055-pound, Colorado-bred Hereford, "George", this year's Lampeter Fair champion, captured the show's reserve title to give Lancaster County a shutout for the top spots. At the sale, George was bid in by Watt & Shand Co., Lancaster, at 38 cents a pound.

Houser, the 19-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Wilbur Houser, Lampeter, is in his last year of 4-H eligibility. His younger brother, Tom, took the county's last reserve cham-

pionship in this show two years ago with another Hereford.

The Shorthorn division was short on entries, but not on quality. With six of the seven entries coming from Lancaster County it looked like a fairly sure win, and it was. The breed championship was won by Mary Lou Landis, Strasburg R1, and reserve honors went to Larry E. Herr, 840 Penn Grant Rd., Lancaster.

Reserve breed titles in the Hereford competition went to a heavyweight steer owned by Shirley Buckwalter, Lititz R3, and shown by Lancaster County Dairy Princess Carol Hess of Strasburg R1.

The only breed title the Lancastrians lost was reserve Angus. This award was retained by Chester County as a fine heavyweight steer shown by Kenneth Beam was not to be denied.

In County Trio competition, Lancaster again placed second to Chester, but ahead of Northampton County. Repre-

senting Lancaster County were: Robert Groff, Peach Bottom R2; Patricia Kreider, Manheim R3; and Sharon Weaver.

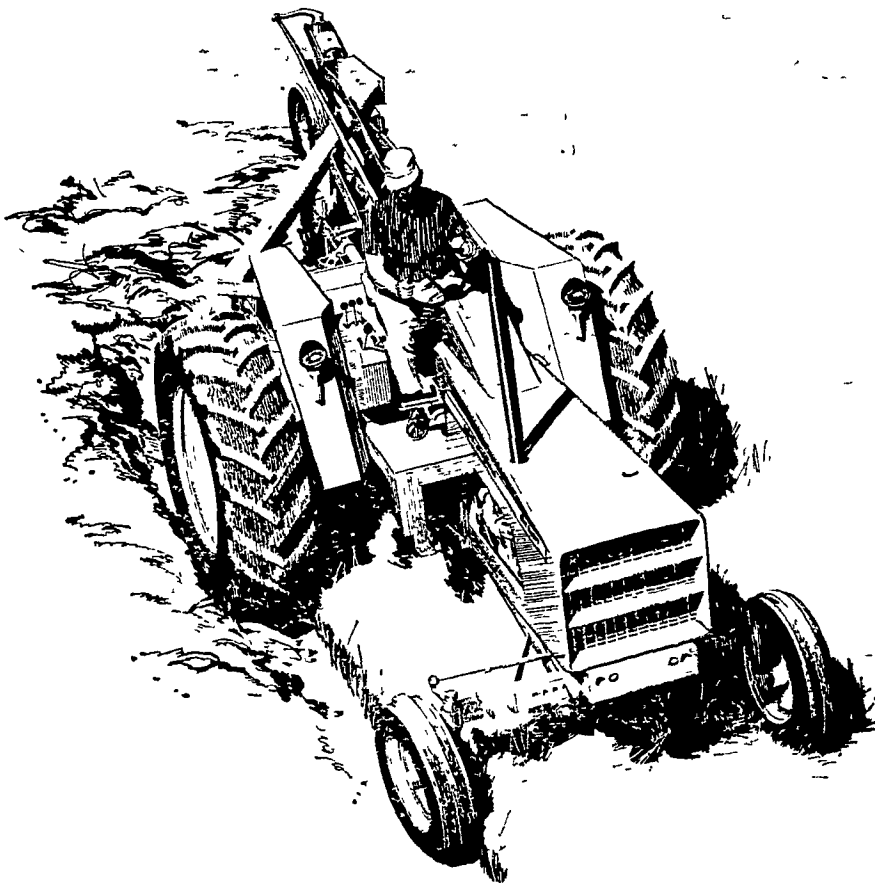
