At Lancaster Yards

Weekly Review

February 3, 1967

CATTLE 3400 — The mid-western snow storm during the past weekend caused reduced mid-western receipts therefore, the increased receipts of slaughter steers at Lancaster on Monday sold 50-100 higher, with a return to normal receipts at midweek a large share of this advance was lost. Closing sales slaughter steers weighing under 1200 lbs steady to 25c lower, over 1200 lbs steady to 25c higher. Cows steady to 50c higher. Bulls mostly steady. Feeder steers fully steady. Supply included an estimated 70 percent slaughter steers, 15 percent Cows and Bulls with the balance largely feeder steers.
