are determined in the New York egg market. Veteran egg market experts feel that such a film will go a long way to dispell many of the misconceptions producers and the general public now hold concerning the nation's most important egg market. When completed, it will be shown to viewers of TV farm programs; local, state and regional poultry producer groups, and to 4-H and FFA Clubs.

Film production and distribution costs have been estimated at \$15,000. NEPPCO, acting through its Board of Directors, has pledged \$5,000 of this amount. The balance, of which \$7,000 has been raised, is to come from firms engaged in or dealing with the egg industry.

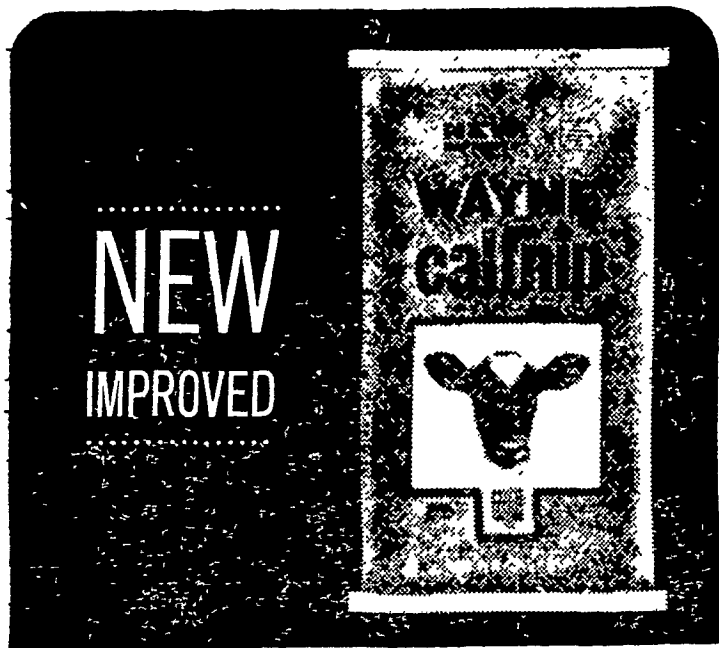
