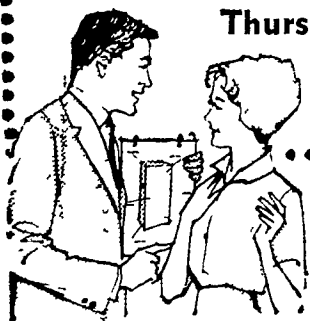

**Some Plants Make Own Poison Agronomist Says**

Some plants apparently have the ability to change harmless 2,4-DB to 2,4-D and kill themselves with the chemical, a researcher said at the 21st annual Northeastern Weed Control Conference held recently in New York.

Reporting on a greenhouse experiment at the University of Maryland, agronomist Dr. Robert Colby said because some plants, particularly alfalfa, do not break the 2,4-DB down into the more potent, 2,4-D readily, they are not usually injured.

But, Colby said, sometimes alfalfa sprayed late in the fall with 2,4-DB will show some injury. To find out why, he set up a series of experiments to see if dormant alfalfa plants might make the chemical break down even though growing alfalfa plants do not.

He found that leaves from dormant plants did contain more 2,4-D than the growing leaves sprayed at the same rate.

But he also found that the soil contained more 2,4-D when the 2,4-DB was sprayed late in the season. Where he found 2,4-D in the soil he also found injury to the alfalfa plants.

Colby believes that the chemical 2,4-DB breaks down first to 2,4-D and then to some other chemical which is not toxic to plants. If the original

chemical is sprayed late in the fall, the cool weather may cause an accumulation of 2,4-D in the soil. This accumulation of toxic chemical does not break down fast enough to prevent injury to the alfalfa.

However, the agronomist said, the damaged alfalfa has great ability to recover. In one field, the injured alfalfa outyielded an unsprayed field nearby. This was partly because of excellent weed control in the sprayed plot.

Most of the injury to alfalfa can be avoided by spraying before the weather turns extremely cold in late fall, Colby concluded.
