their steers for lice and ring-worms, and noted the need for personal cleanliness after treatment of steers. After visiting many first year

members, the county agent said "some have failed to provide an outside exercise lot. It appears you are not recognizing the importance of that." He stressed the need for outside exercise.

Another point he stressed was the need for coarse feed, rather than the finely ground. He said the finely ground feed will cause bloat quicker. Smith also called for the use of pelleted protein, not fine protein, and said the use of silage reduces the cost of feeding.

He told members the timing of the calf, to have it ready for show day, also is important. He said the county roundup will be in November or December, followed by the 1968 Faim Show in January.

The county agent showed slides of cattle-buying trips to Colorado, and of Hawaii, where the 1966 National Assn. of County Agricultural Agents meeting was held.

First, second, and third cutting alfalfa hay sold from \$40.50 to \$44 a ton at the Laban Byers sale Feb. 25, according to auctioneers Diller & Kreider.

The goodwill mission will take the Pennsylvania citizens to Belgium, Spain, Switzerland, Germany, Czechoslovakia, and the Soviet Union.

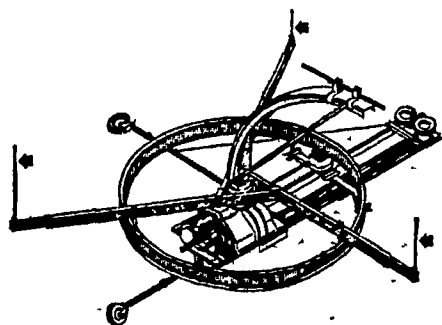

and to improve relations and feelings toward the American people.

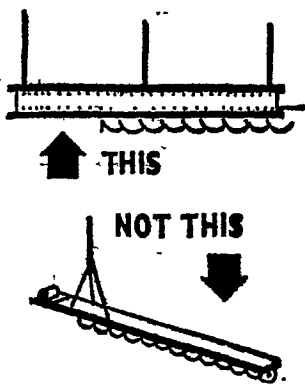
