**Aluminum Foil In The Oven**

Aluminum foil has many uses. But one way not to use it is to line the oven with foil. When you line the bottom of the oven with foil, you are redesigning it so the heat may not circulate properly.

The way to use aluminum foil to catch the overflow from a pie in the oven is to wait until the pie has been in the oven for a while and the pie looks like it's about to bubble over. This is the time to put a piece of foil only slightly larger than the pie pan in the
