points and produced 17,182 pounds of milk and 725 pounds of butterfat in 322 days as a four-year-old.

Clarence Stauffer, Ephrata had to wait until near the end of the day-long sale to register the second high figure for local breeders. His October calf Sunny Craft Melame Ann brought \$470. Ann is sired by Romandale Reflection Marquis (Ex-95) and out of Sunny Side Melame Good Plus 82 with 15,109 pounds of milk and 541 pounds of butterfat. She had two maternal sisters listed in the catalog.

Selling number 11 and starting things off for Lancaster was another Marquis daughter consigned by Daniel S. Stoltzfus, Mt. Joy.

Dan Mai Marquis Rosie, a July calf (born right for the shows) brought third high price for local breeders of \$460. The well-balanced calf is out of Texal Pabst Nancy who has 17,722 pounds of milk and 674 pounds of butterfat in 298 days as a four-year-old.

The ten top calves averaged 400 dollars or more. The entire offering of 134 head averaged \$273 and total receipts were \$36,665.

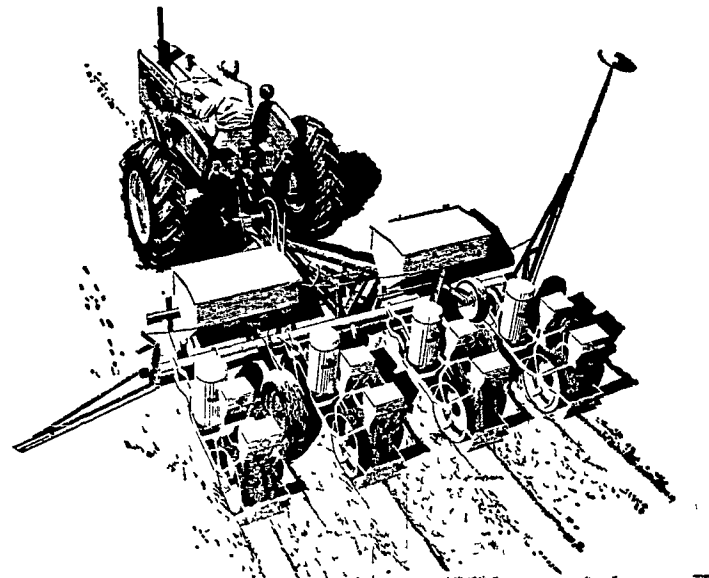
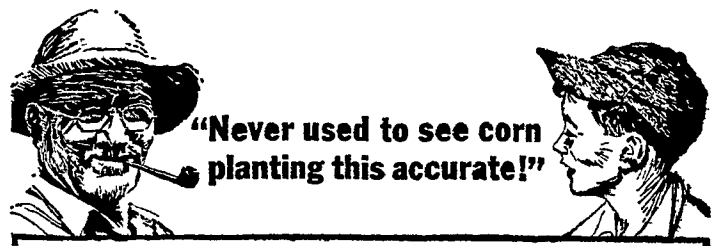
