Prices for light hens were unchanged to 1/4c higher. Demand light and indifferent as some unsettledness developed due in part to lower prices currently being negotiated for ice packed canner style hens. Offerings adequate. Trading on heavy hens very light as a difference of opinion developed between flock owners and buyers. Offerings adequate for a fair interest. Prices paid at farm: Light hens 5-6 1/4, mostly 5 1/2-6 1/2; Heavy Hens, too few to report.

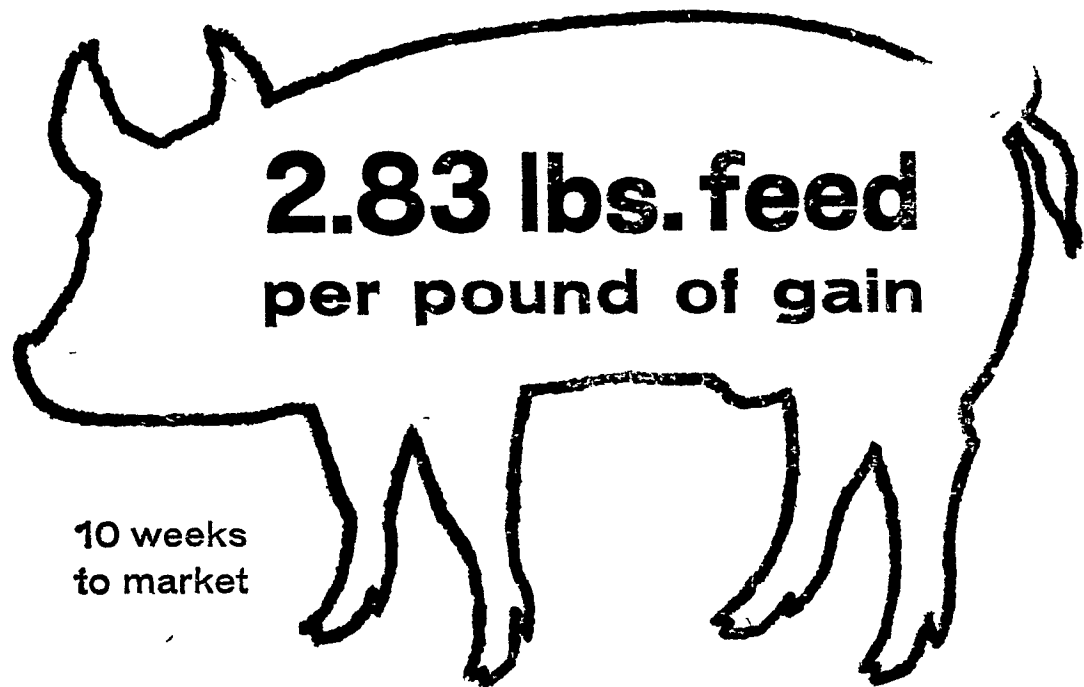
