Wise To Check Temperature In Home Freezer Often

Temperature in your home freezer may vary as you put more food into it

To maintain the best quality of the foods stored in the freezer, the temperature should be zero degrees Fahrenheit or lower

Undesirable changes in flavor, color, and texture may take place in frozen food if the temperature goes above zero degrees

The longer foods are stored in a temperature above zero degrees, the more noticeable these changes become

Proper Lighting Essential For Eye Comfort

For better eye comfort when doing close work, here are some tips that will help assure adequate lighting

Diffused light is spread evenly over the entire work area

Shadows from hands and body are not falling on the work area

Light bulbs are not in direct view or causing glare spots

Desk surfaces and back walls are light-colored or non-glossy

to lessen discomfort from shadows cast on the walls

Walls and ceiling have light thrown on them in addition to the work area

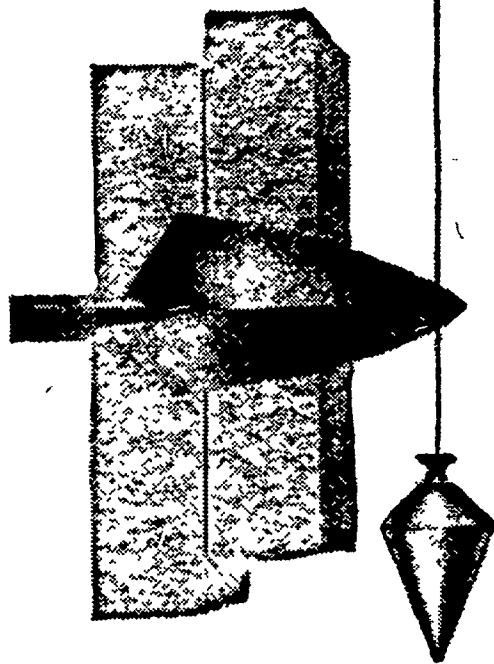

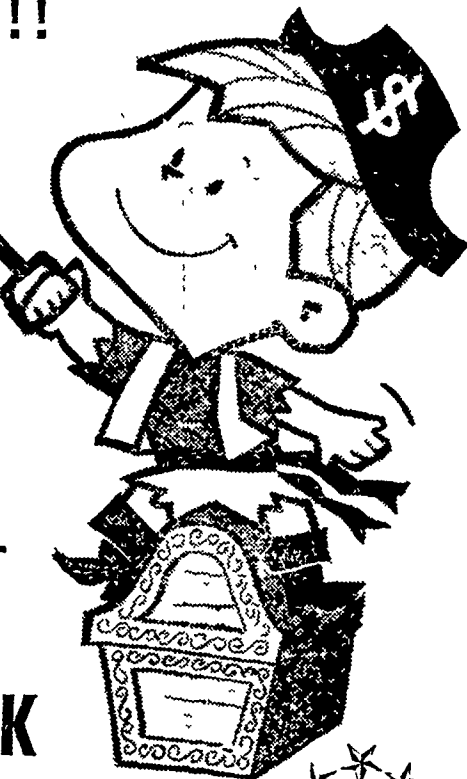
