Judging the 22-class, Lancaster Pony Club show will be J. Carol Tischinger, Cockeysville, Md., Grant Wesner, Reading, Pa., and Mrs J H Tyler McConnell, Wilmington, Del. Mrs McConnell is also regional Pony Club supervisor.

NATIONAL ORGANIZATION
Although the Lancaster Pony Club is only in its 2nd year of operation, the parent national club has a history of 12 years in this country, and dates back considerably further at its point of origin in England. National headquarters for the U S Pony Club is Dover, Massachusetts.

The county is divided into regions, and each region into districts. Many of the districts exchange unofficial shows, Mrs Hassler explains, but there is only one official regional rally. Each of the 11 clubs in this region may send five member teams to the regional rally, which will be held in late June.

"One of the big accomplishments for a pony clubber," Mrs Hassler explains, "is being chosen to represent his

club on a team in the regional competition." Regional winners will go on to the national rally, she adds.

At the regional rally, competition is divided into five phases: dressage, cross-country, stadium jumping, stable management, and a written test. District teams compete only within their own ability levels.

ABILITIES RATED

Four ratings described as "A, B, C, or D" are assigned to all club members from the national organization. They are based on the ability and accomplishment of the individual, with "A" being the highest rating given.

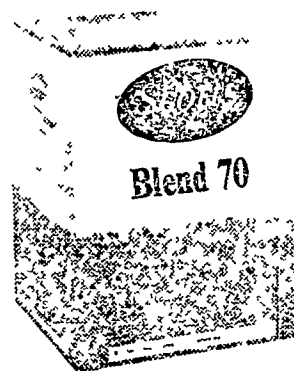
