a day, or twenty hours a week. Their rate of pay varies from \$125 an hour to about \$175. Some of the boys will stay on their jobs through the summer, Ayers said. He based this estimate on last year's results in which nine of the eleven boys in the program were invited to stay on for the summer by their respective employers.

Ayers anticipates that, of next year's senior agriculture class, there will be twelve boys participating in practical educational program.

Corn Products and Funk Bros initiated the commercial breeding, production and sale of hybrid seed corn on an international basis in a joint operation in Italy at that time. Other cooperative programs have followed in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, France, South Africa, and Spain, it was noted.
