

\$18 Million More In Loan Funds To FHA

Secretary of Agriculture Orville L. Freeman announced that President Johnson has released an additional \$18,540,000 in emergency loan funds to

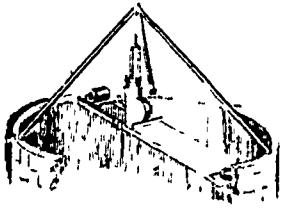
the Farmers Home Administration to meet the loan needs to farmers who have suffered losses caused by natural disaster. Freeman said the additional funds should be sufficient to meet emergency loan needs until the end of this fiscal year,

June 30. These funds, plus \$21 million that was released on March 20, bring the total emergency loan authorization in fiscal 1967 to more than \$103 million—more than \$3 million above 1966. So far this year, more than 1,200 rural counties in 39 States have been designated as

emergency loan areas—most of them on the basis of severe drought conditions, floods, tornadoes, and freezes, the secretary said. The emergency loan funds are obtained from a revolving

fund that has accrued from collections in prior year. The loans provide a standby source of credit to supplement other sources of credit available in areas affected by natural disasters. Interest rate is three percent with repayment scheduled when the farmers' income from crops or livestock is normally resumed.

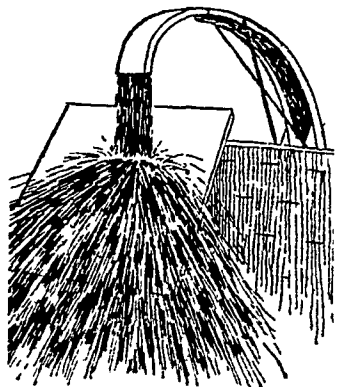
