Slaughter heifers mostly 75 up, cows 50-75 higher, bulls generally 50 higher Receipts 17,900 as compared with 19,800 last week and 22,900 a year ago. Twelve market total 147,500 as compared with 142,000 last week and 173,400 a year ago. Carlot dressed beef at Chicago was 50-1.00 higher on steer, heifer and cow beef.
