

Poultry Serviceman's Handbook Reprinted

A highly-regarded poultry reference text, which until now has been relatively restricted

in circulation to practicing servicemen, has been made more widely available in a paperback version.

The book is the 200-page,

second edition of *The Merck Poultry Serviceman's Manual*. First published in 1958, the manual was originally intended for the use by the nation's poultry servicemen. However, in view of the book's growing reputation as a standard reference text, Merck decided to make the second edition available at cost to others with a legitimate interest in the poultry field.

The second edition has been extensively expanded and updated, and provided with more convenient cross-indexing. Like the first edition, it contains (1) an encyclopedia of poultry diseases, (2) detailed information on disease management and diagnostic procedures, (3) general management tips, complete with a compendium of nutrition husbandry charts and tables.

The new edition of the manual, priced at \$1.45 — its approximate cost—may be purchased directly from Feed Products Department, Merck

Chemical Division, Rahway, New Jersey 07065. In addition, it will be available in book stores of the land grant and other agriculture-oriented colleges.

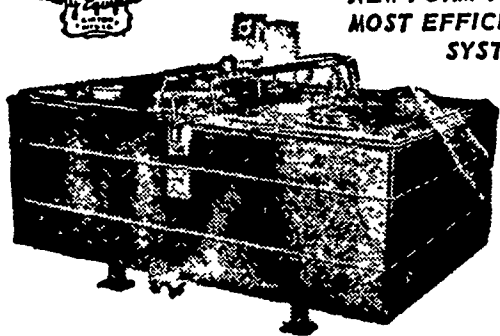

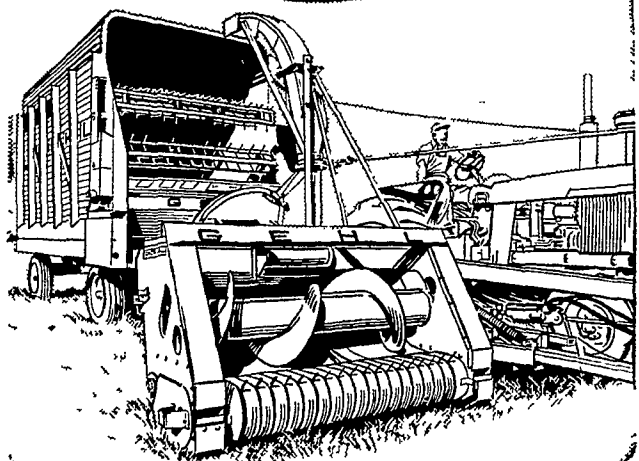

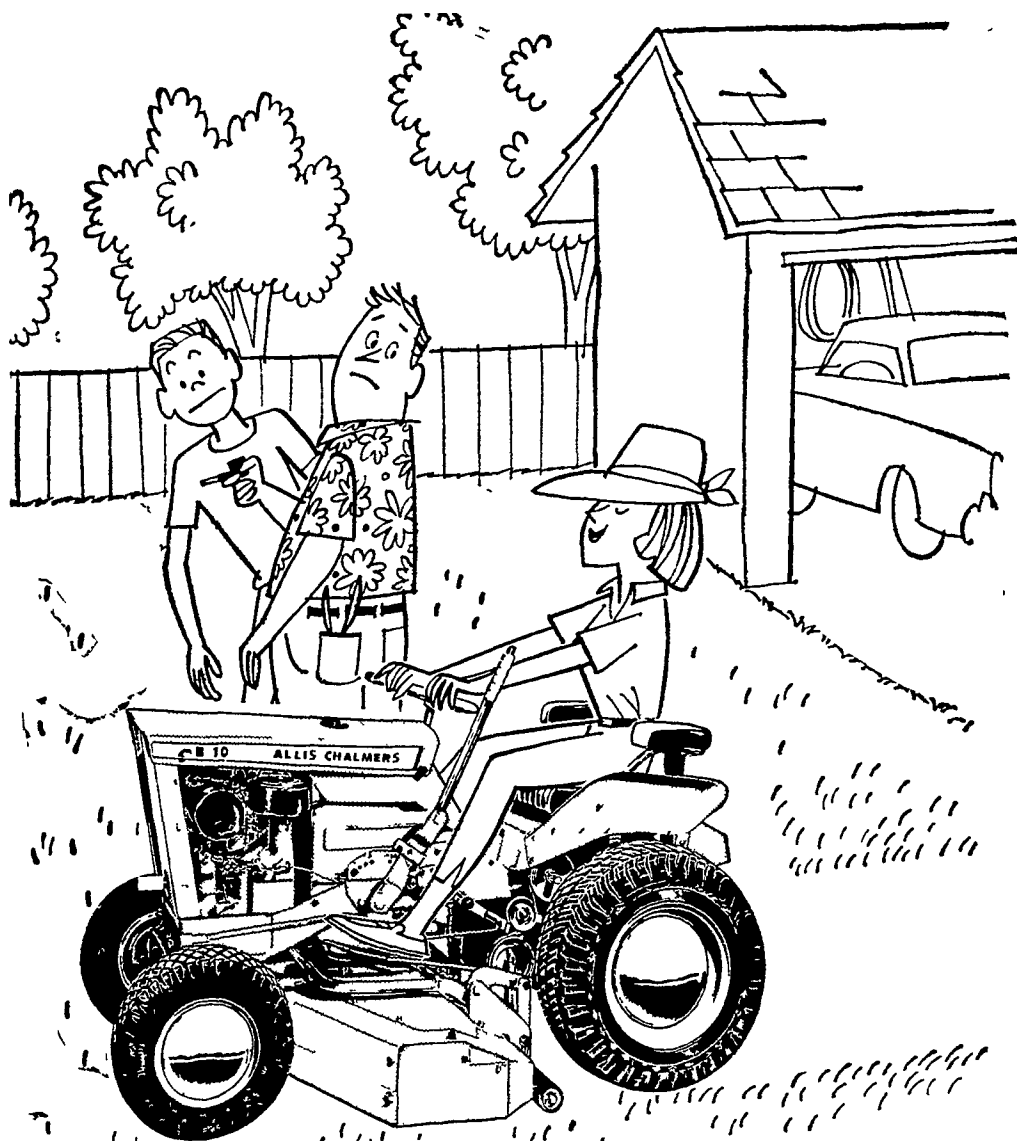
