By regions, December-May farrowings compared with intentions reported last December as percent of a year earlier are: North Atlantic, 101 percent now and 103 percent in December; East North Central, 97 and 102; West North Central, 101 and 101; South Atlantic, 107 and 107; South Central, 104 and 110; and West, 106 and 103.

The average number of pigs per litter was a record high of 7.34 for December-May compared with 7.32 a year earlier. The number of sows farrowing during each month of the December-May period ranged from 96 percent of the same month a year earlier in April to 111 percent in December.
