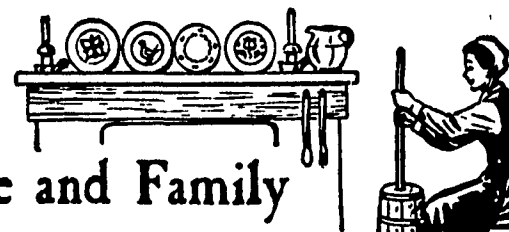

Tops in buttermilk in the Red Rose Dairy Herd Improvement Association for the month of June was the 40-head, registered Holstein herd of Donald S. Eby, Gordonville R1. Eby's herd averaged 1557 lbs. of milk and 69 lbs. of fat. Runnerup for butterfat for the month was the 23-cow, registered Holstein herd of Alvin K. Bollinger, Lititz R1. His herd averaged 64 lbs. with 1592 lbs of milk.

High cow honors for 305-day lactation went to a registered Holstein owned by Mahlon M. Fry of Elizabethtown R1. She produced 20,827 lbs. of milk and 847 lbs of fat. Second high lactation was completed by a registered Holstein owned by Lloyd Wolf, Quarryville R2. She made 20,524 lbs. of milk and 791 of butterfat.

Some Tips On Broiling Meat

Keep steaks, chops, and ham slices from curling around the edges when you're broiling them. Slash through outside fat covering at one-inch intervals.

It's best not to broil veal.

You can broil frozen meats or those partially thawed.

Rule of Thumb For Buying Eggs

When trying to decide which is the best buy in eggs — small, medium, or large, remember this rule:

If the difference in price between two consecutive sized dozen is greater than seven cents, buy the smaller sized dozen.

If the difference in price between the two

different sizes is less than seven cents, buy the larger eggs.

When egg prices are higher in the fall, use the same rule but use eight cents as a guide.

You can substitute consecutive sized eggs easily in most recipes.

Starting Barbecue Fires

Line the bottom of the fire bowl with heavy duty aluminum foil for easier cleaning.

A fire base of gravel or similar material about one-inch deep permits the fire to "breathe," giving more heat from the coals.

After 4 to 6 barbecues, wash the fire base to remove drippings and ash. Be sure the fire base is thoroughly dry before using, since gravel may explode if heated when wet.

Stack briquets in a pyramid. Soak lightly with charcoal lighting fluid. Let stand one minute and light.

When the surface is covered with gray ash, spread coals evenly and the fire is ready for cooking. This method takes about 45 minutes.

Guides For Sewing or Buying Children's Clothes

Shoulder seams are at the shoulder line, not drooping over the shoulder bone.

Waistlines are midway between hip bone and end of rib cage.

Pants legs and sleeves don't drag.

When sewing at home, select a pattern nearest the child's measurements.

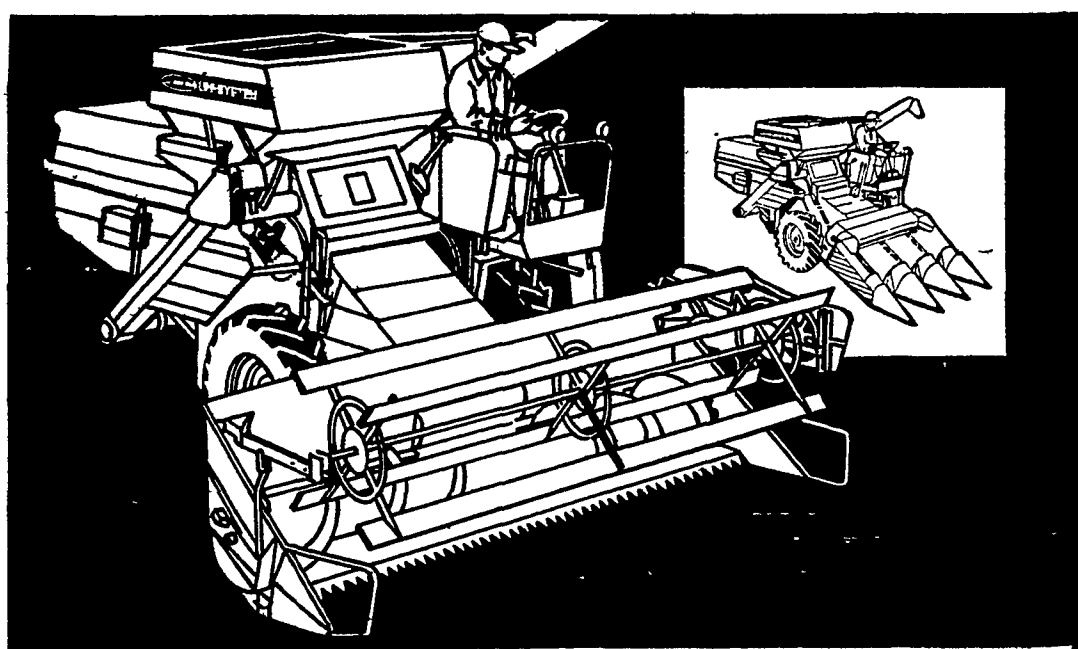
Age is not a good guide in determining size. Take measurements before cutting the fabric.

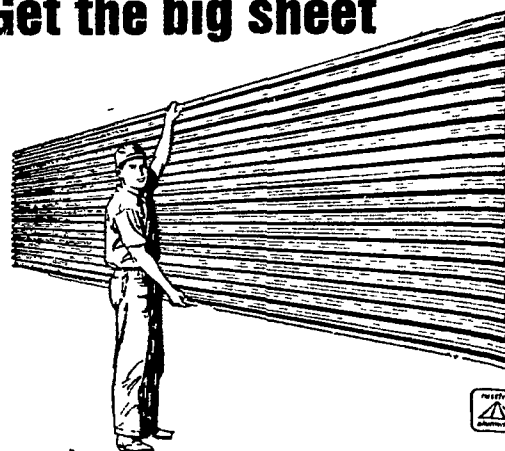
