



Sex is a factor because heifeis finish at lighter weights than steers

Sewell reminds that after cattle reach middle choice glade, it takes more feed to add a pound of gain Thus, gains beyond that grade are usually more expensive to the feeder The premium paid for higher slaughter grades generally does not offset increased feed costs

Based on these factors, a ' rule of thumb" is to sell cattle at high good to middle choice grades


Steers should reach this grade at 950 to 1 100 pounds The comparable weight for heifers is 800 to 950 pounds

Low quality feeders should be sold at lower grades
